# Prescriptive Lighting Efficiency Program Guidelines

Replace 400-watt Metal Halide with 4 or 6 lamp, 54W T5HO Fluorescent High Bay	<b>\$60 per fixture</b>
Replace 320-watt Metal Halide with 4 or 6 lamp, 32W T8 Fluorescent High Bay	<b>\$60 per fixture</b>
Replace 250-watt Metal Halide with 3 or 4 lamp, 32T8 Fluorescent High Bay	<b>\$40 per fixture</b>
Replace/Retrofit Incandescent Exit Signs w/ LED	<b>\$10 per fixture</b>
Replace/Retrofit T12, 4 lamp - 4' Fluorescent with T8 and Electronic Ballast	<b>\$16 per fixture</b>
Replace/Retrofit T12, 3 lamp fixtures - 4' with T8 and Electronic Ballast	<b>\$12 per fixture</b>
Replace/Retrofit T12, 2 lamp fixtures - 4' with T8 and Electronic Ballast	<b>\$8 per fixture</b>
Replace/Retrofit T12, 1 lamp fixtures - 4' with T8 and Electronic Ballast	<b>\$4 per fixture</b>
Replace/Retrofit any 8' T12 with any 8' T8 with Electronic Ballast	<b>\$12 per fixture</b>
Replace 150W incandescent with CFL - 150W equivalent	<b>\$5 per lamp</b>
Replace 200W incandescent with CFL - 200W equivalent	<b>\$5 per lamp</b>
Replace 250W incandescent with CFL - 250W equivalent	<b>\$5 per lamp</b>
Replace 300W incandescent with CFL - 300W equivalent	<b>\$7 per lamp</b>
Replace 350W incandescent with CFL - 350W equivalent	<b>\$7 per lamp</b>
Replace 500W incandescent with CFL - 500W equivalent	<b>\$8 per lamp</b>
Replace 600W incandescent with CFL - 600W equivalent	<b>\$8 per lamp</b>
Replace fluorescent freezer/refrigerator case light with LED	<b>\$25 per fixture</b>

***Qualifying systems include:***

- Existing facilities only, no new Construction.
- Commercial and Industrial customers qualify for the new energy-efficient fluorescent fixtures. Other customers may qualify at the discretion of their local electric utility.
- Upgrade projects seeking more than \$5,000 in incentives require pre-approval and possible inspection by their local electric utility.
- Dusk-to-Dawn lighting, including street lighting, floodlighting, wall pack units, or other exterior (outside) lighting does not qualify.

# Prescriptive Lighting Efficiency Program Guidelines

The following guidelines will apply. Exceptions will be handled on a case by case basis.

1. All replaced or retrofitted lighting equipment must be permanently installed.
2. Commercial and Industrial customers qualify for the new energy-efficient fluorescent fixture incentives. Other customers may qualify at the discretion of their local electric utility.
3. All incentives sought that are \$5,000 or greater require pre-installation notification and potential inspection by the local electric utility.
4. The Commercial/Industrial & Area Lighting Efficiency Program is a “one-to-one” program in that an equal number of lighting fixtures will be impacted when compared to the number of fixtures considered for retrofit or replacement. If the quantity of existing or new fixtures is not equal, the lesser quantity will apply. Only existing lighting systems qualify for the upgrade. New construction or the addition of more light fixtures in a facility or facility addition does not qualify.
5. An incentive will be provided to the person responsible for the utility account after the equipment is installed and operating. No incentive(s) will be paid without the completion of the application form. The application form must then be signed by the owner and installing contractor (if applicable). The completed application form will then be submitted to the electric utility for processing. Sales receipt(s) or invoice(s) itemizing the new equipment and indicating the size, type, make, model, purchase date, and vendor must accompany each energy efficiency incentive application.
6. The incentive payment or account credit to the owner will come directly from their local electric utility.
7. NPPD reserves the right to do random spot checks of the performance verifications to ensure program compliance.
8. Participating electric utilities are those that are wholesale customers of Nebraska Public Power District.
9. NPPD will make final determination of program compliance decisions and reserves the right to cancel the program with 30 days notice.
